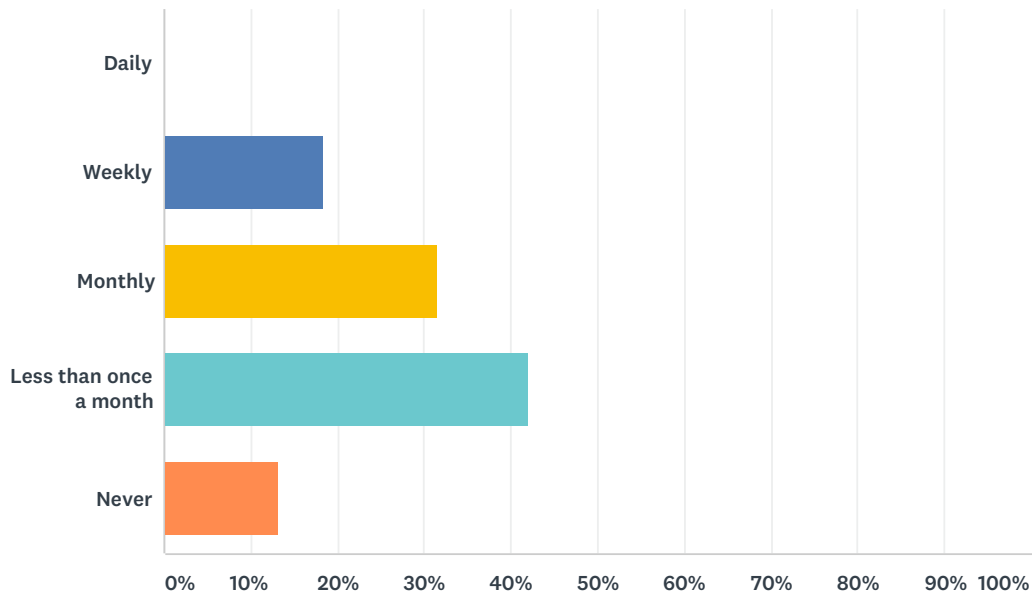


Q1 On average, how often do you expect to visit the Napa County Law Library once it reopens?

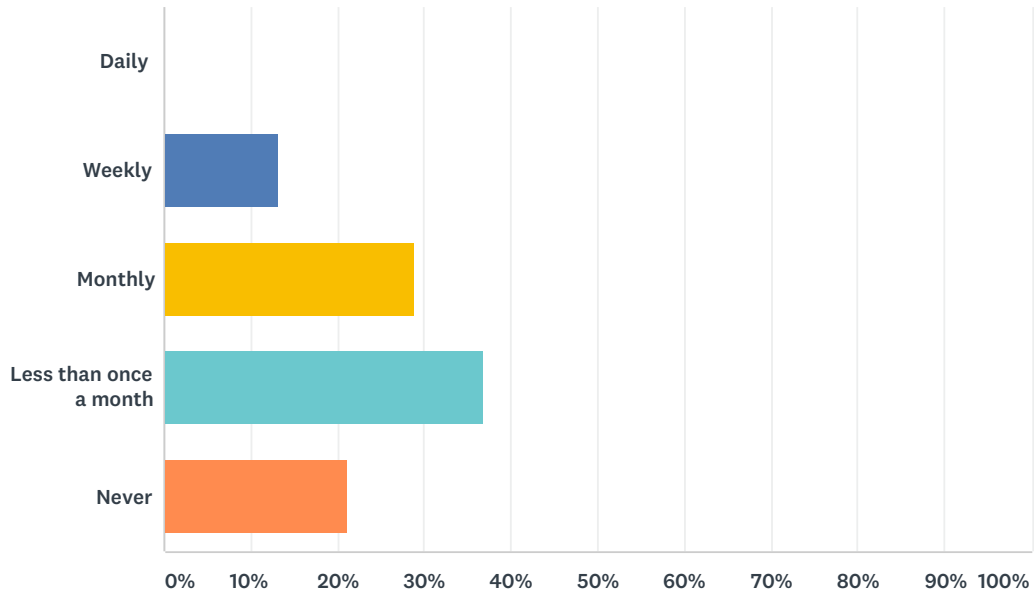

Q2 How often would you use the Law Library's database(s) (e.g. Westlaw) for legal research?

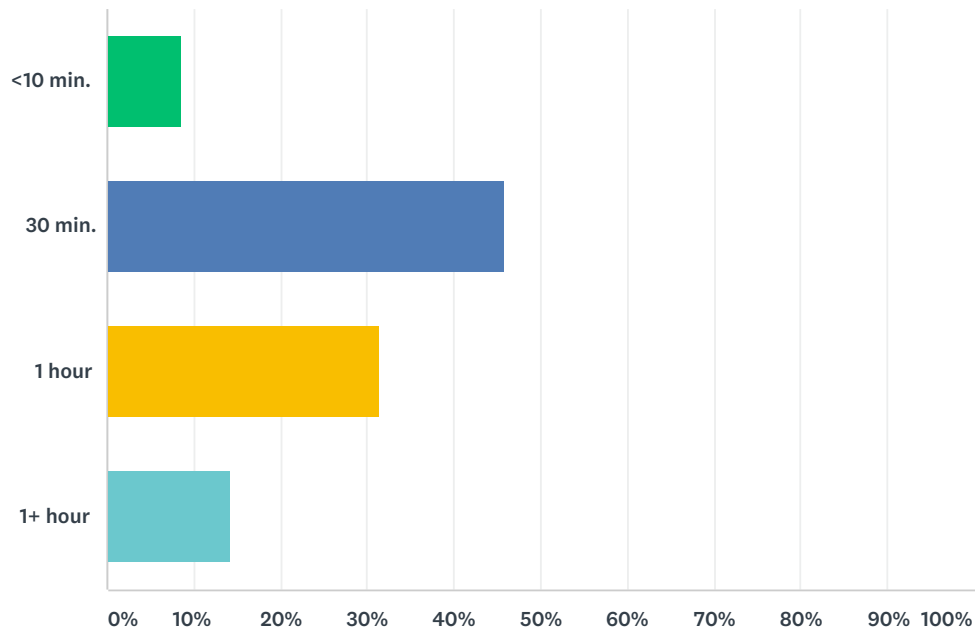

Q3 If you would use the Law Library's databases(s) (e.g. Westlaw), how long would your average session be?

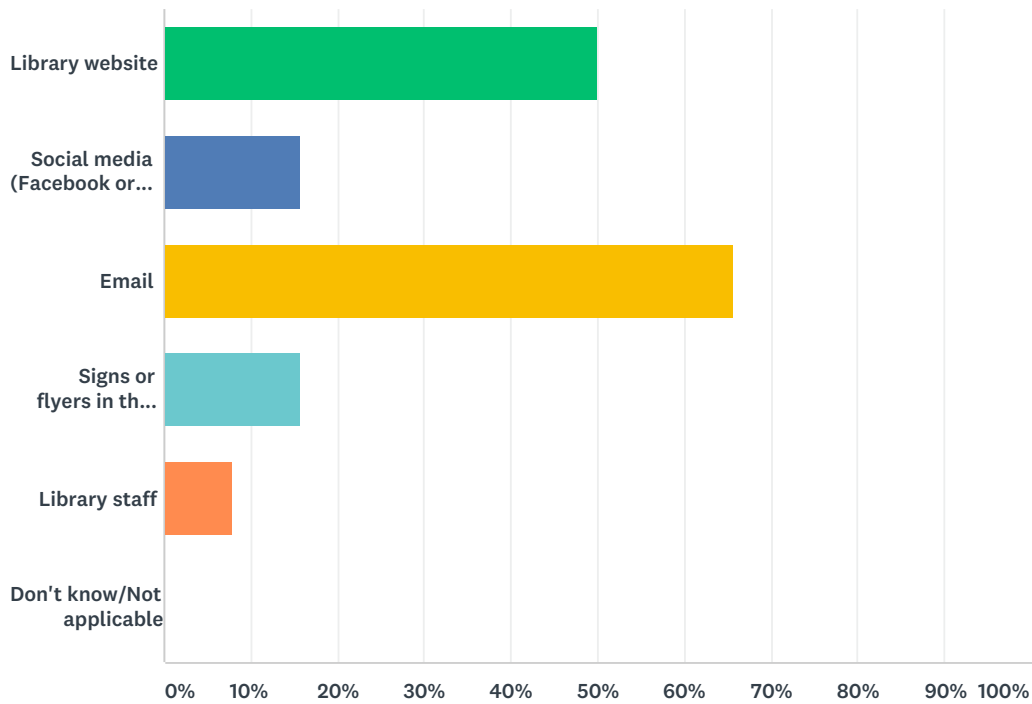

Q4 How would you prefer to find out about Law Library resources and programs?

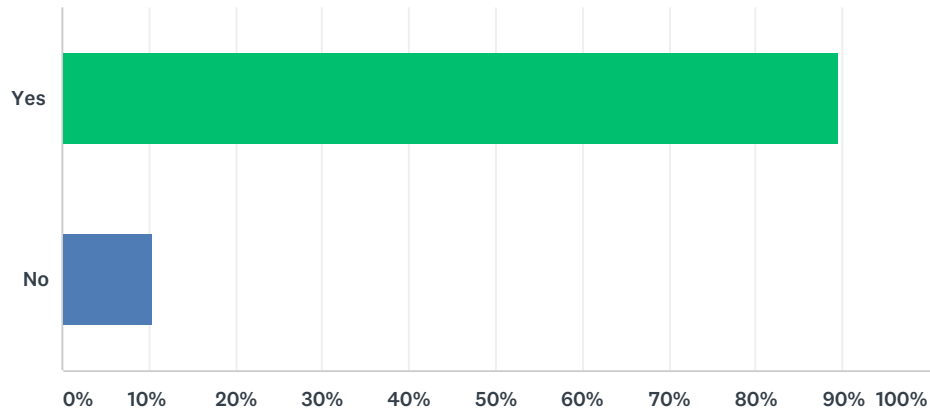

Q5 Do you work in the legal profession?

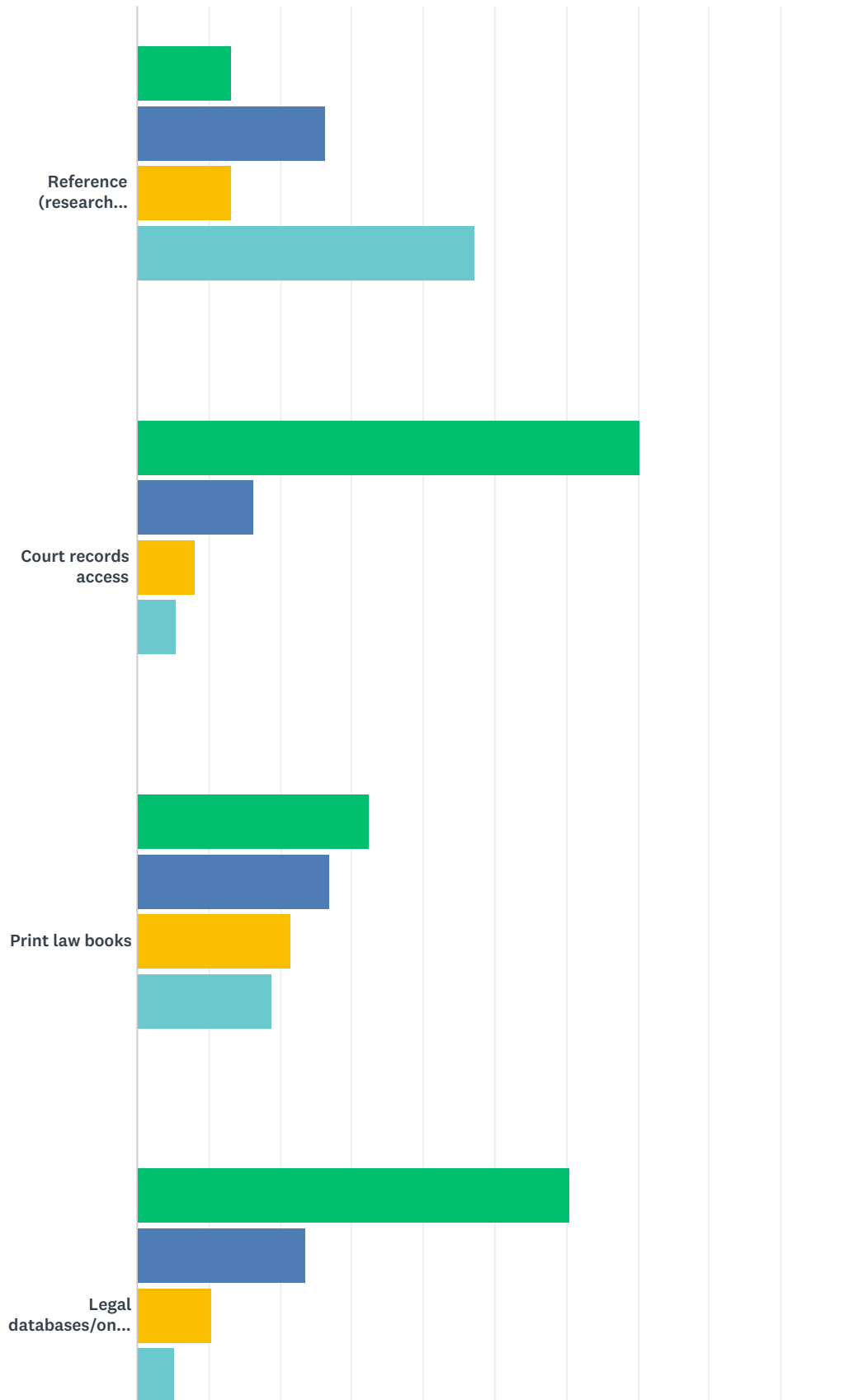

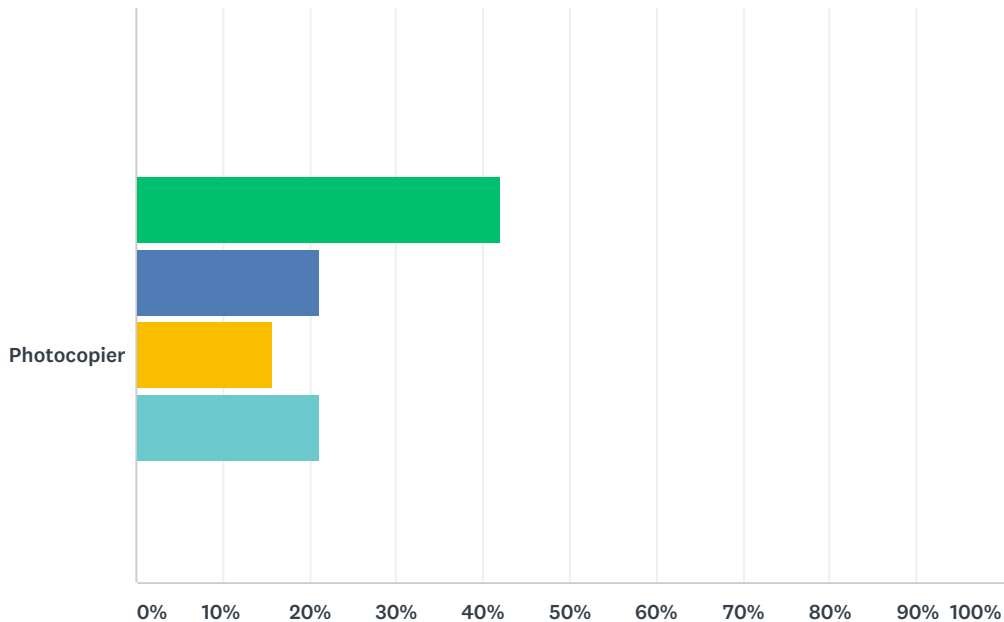

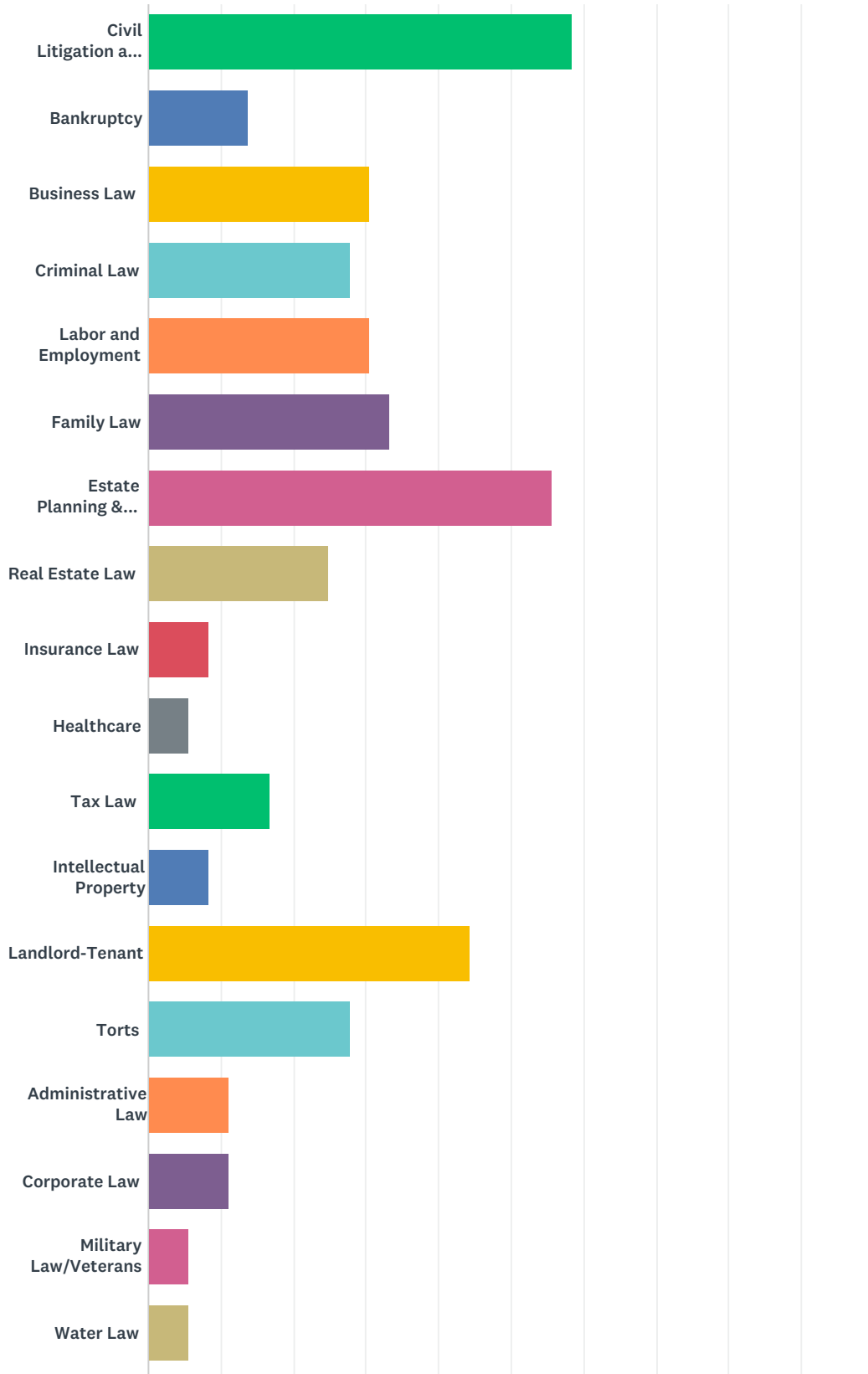
